Explore Fancy Saddles

Saddles are seats that allow people to ride on top of animals such as horses and camels. There are many different kinds of saddles. Some saddles are made for working and riding while other saddles are designed for parades and special shows.

Can you find these saddles?

- A colorful saddle decorated with beads made by a Crow woman for riding.
- The big saddle made by Hollywood saddle-maker Edward H. Bolin for parades.
- An elegant dark leather saddle with pictures of *vaqueros* (cowboys) and flowers stamped into the leather. This saddle was not made for everyday riding and reflected the high status of the saddle's owner.

Green Screen
