

Social Story




This is a garden about plants and their relationship with people.

If we go left, we will see a large image of rocks found in Mammoth, California. We will also find seating underneath it. This is the Northwest/Central California Section.




As we continue along the path, we'll see a waterfall, a stream, and plants that grow in and around water.




The chairs that look like eggs are there for anyone to take a rest.

The circle on the ground is actually called a 'Ceremonial Circle.' It is used in Native American traditions and ceremonies.
